

Convoy Route and Map



- A. **Starting Point** is at the Oak Bay Marina. Arrive at 3:30pm. Sign in. Take place in line.
- B. **Hold Zone #1** is on Warren Gardens where the Convoy can reassemble. Arrives at 4:12pm
- C. **Hold Zone #2** is on Monterey Ave where the Convoy can reassemble. Arrives at 4:20pm
- D. **Reno Site.** Drive by at 4:25pm.
- E. **Parking Zone** is in the Victoria College of Art. Arrives at 4:27pm.
- F. **March onto Site** starts at the corner of Leighton Rd and Davie Street.

Convoy instructions

- Get pumped! We're going to have a great time. If you're game decorate your vehicle with slogans like "Community is Power" "Youth are our Future" "Heroes Rarely Wear Capes" or whatever tickles your fancy.
 - Arrive at 3:30pm at the Oak Bay Marina Restaurant parking lot, 1327 Beach Drive. There will be attendees there to direct traffic and show you where to park. Then go to the sign-in tent. Extra maps will be available, as well as waivers, and decals for sponsors.
 - The Convoy leaves at 4pm sharp. Remember to honk your horn, cheer, and wave at people passing by.
- Everyone must obey all traffic signs and speed limits.** This means that the Convoy will break up a bit while on route. However we've designed a few "hold areas" where the convoy will slow and come back

- together before heading off again. (This is a better solution than costing the city thousands of dollars in police escorts and road closures.)
- After snaking it's way through the city the Convoy arrives at the reno site (1502 Davie Street) at 4:30pm. Once on site there will be traffic people to direct you where to park.
- Gather for the "March onto the Site" at the corner of Leighton and Davie St. (on map).
- The "March" begins at 5pm and will be captured by video cameras. (Remember to smile!)
- Then there will be a few speeches, followed by the demo, and the kickoff party. Awesome!
